NATIONAL PRESIDENT-ELECT

Responsibilities:

- 1) Attends National Council meetings and Conclave sessions,
- 2) Serves as Chairperson of the National Professional Program Committee which
 - a) Directs the National Professional Program for the biennium,
 - b) Reviews chapter Professional Program reports and selects recipients for Professional Program awards, and
- 3) Accepts the responsibilities of the Presidency if for any reason the latter becomes unable to serve; or after 2 years as President-elect.

Qualifications:

- 1) Active in the field of Family and Consumer Sciences or related area,
- 2) Shows an active interest in Phi Upsilon Omicron, and
- 3) May have served as a chapter advisor, an alumni chapter officer or on National Council.

Term of Office: The term of office is six years, 2016 – 2022, beginning at the close of Conclave 2016: two years as president-elect, two years as president, and two years as past president

DIRECTOR, EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

Responsibilities:

- 1) Manage the affairs of the Foundation and
- 2) Enlist, develop, and manage the special financial interests, which support the Professional Program of the Honor Society.

Qualifications:

- 1) Be alumni members, and
- 2) Possess national visibility and reputation in order to best represent, from the Board's perspective, both the Honor Society and the profession of Family and Consumer Sciences.

Term of Office: The term of office is four years, 2016-2020, beginning at the close of 2016 Conclave.

NATIONAL ADVISOR COUNCILOR

Responsibilities:

- 1) Attends National Council meetings and Conclave sessions,
- 2) Serves as a liaison between chapter advisors and National Council,
- 3) Creates programming to update and assist chapter advisors.

Qualifications:

- 1) Active in the field of Family and Consumer Sciences or related area,
- 2) Shows an active interest in Phi Upsilon Omicron,
- 3) Has served as a chapter advisor, and
- 4) May have served as an alumni chapter officer or on National Council.

Term of Office: The term of office is four years, 2016-2020, beginning at the close of 2016 Conclave.
