

Jean Dearth Dickerscheid Fellowship

Awarded to a student pursuing a Ph.D. and has earned at least one other degree in family and consumer sciences. The applicant must intend to pursue a career in academia.

Margaret Drew Alpha Fellowship

Awarded to a student for graduate study with preference given to a dietetics or food and nutrition major.

Presidents' Research Fellowship

Awarded to a student for graduate research at the master's or doctoral level. Application must include research prospectus exhibiting organization and need for the research.

Alumni Awards

Deadline: June 1
(even-numbered years)

Helen D. Chromy Conclave Travel Grant (1 for \$200)

Awarded to an advisor who has never attended Conclave. Criteria for selection include the accomplishments of the chapter under the advisor's leadership and the advisor's potential for promoting chapter growth.

Deadline: November 1
(odd-numbered years)

Alumni Research Grant (1 for \$2,500)

Awarded for support of post graduate research work not necessarily leading to an advanced degree. Selection will be made on the following basis: use of money in the applicant's research, value of research problem, and professional aims and goals. Research prospectus must accompany the application.

Deadline: November 1 (annually)

Bachtel/Holbrook Collegiate Advisor Award (1 for \$300)

Criteria for selection include the accomplishments of the chapter under the advisor's leadership and demonstrated excellence as a collegiate chapter advisor.

Deadline: November 1
(odd-numbered years)

Florence Fallgatter Distinguished Service Award (Award to defray expenses to attend Conclave)

Awarded to an alumni member for outstanding achievements in family and consumer sciences during a minimum of 10 years of employment or volunteer activities.

Preference given to majors in dietetics or food and nutrition.

Preference given to majors in clothing and textiles or a related area such as apparel design or fashion merchandising. This student must have held a leadership position in her/his Phi U chapter and have earned at least a 3.0 out of 4.0 overall grade point average.

Additional statement required.

[Margaret Jerome Sampson Scholarships](#)

(5 for \$4,000 each)
Preference given to majors in dietetics or food and nutrition who provide evidence of financial need. Additional statement required.

(2 for \$2,000 each)
Preferences given to non-traditional students. Additional statement required.

Graduate/Undergraduate Awards

Deadline: February 1

Graduating seniors are eligible for all of the Phi U awards.

The following Awards range from \$250 - \$300

Awarded to a graduating senior for exemplary service to their local chapters. At least one recommendation must be from the local chapter advisor.

[Janice Cory Bullock Award](#)

Awarded to a non-traditional undergraduate or graduate student.

[Lynne White Scheider Award](#)

Awarded to a student for demonstrated leadership and scholarship in the area of consumer affairs, personal finance, or family finance.

[Orinne Johnson Writing Award](#)

Awarded to a student who submits the most outstanding creative writing for publication in THE CANDLE.

[Sarah Thorniley Phillips Leadership Awards \(2\)](#)

Awarded to students for outstanding leadership and participation in collegiate and community programs.

[Shirley Noah Chase Award](#)

Awarded to a student with preference given to family and consumer sciences education majors.

[Karen P. Goebel Conclave Award](#) (awarded in even-numbered years) (1 for \$500)

Awarded to an undergraduate student for initiative in planning and raising funds to attend Conclave. The student must have 2 semesters or 3 quarters remaining in school after Conclave.

Graduate Fellowships

Deadline: February 1

Graduate Fellowships are awarded to students pursuing graduate degrees in family and consumer sciences or a related area. Selection based upon scholastic record; honors and recognitions; participation in honor society, professional, community, and other organizations; scholarly work; statement of professional goals; and recommendations.

The following Fellowships range from \$750 - \$1,500

[Candle Fellowship](#)

Awarded to a student enrolled in or planning to enroll in a master's degree program.

[Diamond Anniversary Fellowship](#)

Awarded to a student who has been accepted into or currently enrolled in a master's or doctoral program.

[Founders Fellowship](#)

Awarded to a student who has completed at least half the credit-hour requirements toward a doctorate degree.

[Geraldine Clewell Fellowship](#)

Awarded to a doctoral student with preference given to a student who desires to teach at the college/university level.

[Geraldine Clewell Fellowship](#)

Awarded to a master's degree student, with preference given to a student majoring in family and consumer sciences education who desires to teach at the elementary/secondary level.
