Undergraduate students shall be eligible to be a collegiate member of a chapter if the individual has completed a minimum of 36 semester hours, 50 quarter hours, or the equivalent. The hours must include 6 hours of course work in areas including, but not limited to, those recognized by the American Association of Family and Consumer Sciences (AAFCS).
