GreekTrack is a robust software application your chapter can use to stay organized. Phi Upsilon Omicron encourages everyone to use GreekTrack to manage their chapter.

To access GreekTrack: Click "Login" (upper right side) on the Phi U Website, then click on your Phi U chapter, and it will lead you on into the system. Once logged in on your GreekTrack Dashboard Page, scroll about halfway down and locate RESOURCES—VIEW ALL on the right-hand side. This will take you to folders organized by officer and/or membership type. To view your chapter's membership, locate MEMBERS across the menu at the top of your GreekTrack Dashboard.
